General Sick Policy

Children should not be in school when they are ill or symptomatic.

Students who demonstrate signs of illness—fever, diarrhea or vomiting, persistent cough, head lice, nits (eggs), or green or brown mucus emitting from the nose or eyes—must be kept home. If your child becomes ill during the day, a parent will be notified, and the child must be picked up. We may ask you to consult with a physician if your child exhibits a fever of 101 degrees or above at school.

COVID-19 Protocols

Children should not be in camp when they are ill or symptomatic.

If Your Child Tests Positive for COVID-19...

Student may return to scamp if:

Option One:

- Student received a negative test, has been fever free for 24 hours, and symptoms are improving.

Option Two:

- Ten (10) days have passed since symptoms onset or positive test; the student may return to camp on day eleven (11). Student needs to be fever free for 24 hours and his/her symptoms are improving.

If Your Child is Exposed to COVID-19...

You will be informed by staff

- Students may attend camp and all camp-related activities if he/she remains asymptomatic. Symptomatic students must stay home. If an exposed student showing symptoms attends school, he/she will be sent home.

Option Two:

- Quarantine for a period up to seven (7) days and returning no later than day eight (8) if the student remains asymptomatic.

If a child is sick, You will not be credited for a day(s) missed mid week. However, you may receive a credit if you miss a full week due to illness.
